Civic Prayer Breakfast, Old Library Building

From the Haymarket, enter the campus by the Campus Coffee café, opposite St Thomas' Church. Up the steps; straight ahead and under the arches; and through the gardens. At the end, go down steps on your right. The entrance to the Old Library Building is on your right.

From Claremont Road Car Park, come down Claremont Road, straight ahead past the entrance to Exhibition Park. Cross Claremont Road by the light-controlled crossing. The Old Library Building is straight ahead, beyond the lawns, and the entrance is on the right.
